








Quality Matters

- QM Standard 3 Assessment & Measurement
 - 3.1 The assessments measure the achievement of the stated learning objectives or competencies.
 - 3.2 The course grading policy is stated clearly at the beginning of the course.
 - 3.3. Specific and descriptive criteria are provided for the evaluation of learners' work, and their connection to the course grading policy is clearly explained.
 - 3.4 The assessments used are sequenced, varied, and suited to the level of the course.
 - 3.5 The course provides learners with multiple opportunities to track their learning progress with timely feedback.




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Backwards Design











Produce new or original work

Design, assemble, construct, conjecture, develop, formulate, author, investigate

evaluate

Justify a stand or decision

appraise, argue, defend, judge, select, support, value, critique, weigh

analyze

Draw connections among ideas

differentiate, organize, relate, compare, contrast, distinguish, examine, experiment, question, test

apply

Use information in new situations

execute, implement, solve, use, demonstrate, interpret, operate, schedule, sketch

understand

Explain ideas or concepts

classify, describe, discuss, explain, identify, locate, recognize, report, select, translate

remember

Recall facts and basic concepts define, duplicate, list, memorize, repeat, state



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Authentic assessments require judgment, innovation, and application... in realistic contexts





Authentic Assessments

- An assignment is authentic if it
 - o is realistic.
 - o requires judgment and innovation.
 - o asks the student to "do" the subject.
 - replicates or simulates the workplace, civic, or personal context.
 - allows for rehearsal, practice, consultation, and feedback to refine performances and products.



Authentic Alternatives

- 1. Observations / Interviews
- 2. Annotated bibliography
- 3. Video Presentations
- 4. Reflections / applications
- 5. Fact Sheets / Infographics / How-To Manuals
- 6. Group Projects





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Assignment Create/Edit Experience



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




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Observed in Person Submission



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
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On Paper Submission



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
Rubrics

 - Refine teaching methods by evaluating rubric results




Rubrics

 - Improve work through timely and detailed feedback











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Assignments Tool Tip #2

 - Given the option to copy associated grade item and rubric





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

Design with accessibility in mind









Potential Pitfall

- Anonymous markings
